Unless otherwise stated, all courses commence at 8am and finish at 5pm

301 should be taken first, though 302 or 305 can be taken before 301. For Endodontists 303 is a special course that is arranged if/when there is demand after taking the 301 course. Courses 551 and 552 run throughout the year with dates and times arranged for mutual convenience of all involved. It usually takes 9-18 months to complete the MII Externship curriculum for doctors and staff.

Program Modules

301 How to do the SIMPLE procedures of implant placement and restoration.

Review of the basic Anatomy, Physiology and Pathology, Implant Design, Surgical Template, Bone Morphology, Diagnosis and Treatment Planning, Radiography, Pharmacology, Patient selection, Documentation, Avoiding Malpractice. Understand the basics of anatomy pertaining to implant dentistry, Explains the basics of implant placement in mandibular and maxillary bone, Tissue Management of simple implant placement. (2 day).

302 Teamwork for a successful implant office

Sterile technique for implantology: protocol and documentation for treatment planning and proper patient consent, surgical template construction. 302 will allow time to do proper Diagnosis and Treatment Planning with dental implants, construction of proper useful surgical stents by Doctor/staff, Doctor/staff use of sterile technique to get predictable results, Hands-on implant placement in artificial mandibles utilizing staff to help the doctor place the implants correctly, Incorporating proper suturing techniques for better tissue closure, How to talk to patients about the benefits of dental implants, Oral hygiene responsibility of patient and staff members, MII Protocol of preparing Doctor/staff/ their patient with dental implant treatment at MII facility. (2 day).

303 Keeping Endo Implants Simple (Taught after taking 301)

version of 301 for Endodontists. with content specific to Endodontists.

305 Implant Prosthetics.

Even if you don't do surgery, learn how to restore so you keep your patient in your practice. Teaches the different basic concepts and the types of prosthetics components from different implant systems. (2 days).

551 Extern program part 1

Preparing your patient selections and assisting with placing implants in your own patients. (Approximately 20-30 hrs CE)
Requirements:- Maxillary anterior/posterior using bone spreading techniques, Mandibular anterior/posterior using rotary instrumentation– Appointment times arranged on a Wednesday or Friday.

552 Extern program part 2

The same as 551 but Doctor/staff perform surgery under supervision and guidance.

How and when to graft (and when not to). Types of graft materials, use of PRP and other adjuncts. Bring your own patients for hands on surgery. (2 day).

604 Lateral nerve Repositioning learn with Piezosurgery and traditional Techniques. Lecture and live surgery.
